Substance Abuse Professional Evaluations for Employees working in Safety sensitive positions regulated by the (DOT) Department of Transportation. Our Qualified Substance Abuse Professionals (SAPs) are trained to complete evaluations for people working in the field of Truck Driving (CDL) drivers, Oil and Gas, Railroads, and the Aviation Industry.



The SAP Process Includes

- A 48-hour response time face to face clinical assessment.
- Referral for treatment and/or education (Determined by the SAP)
- SAP monitoring of employee in treatment
- Face to face follow up clinical evaluation to determine if employee has complied
- Follow up testing schedule
- Aftercare recommendations (as deemed necessary)
- Written reports sent to the employers designated representative keeping them informed of progress and recommendations

Failed Drug Test

- Violation of Federal DOT drug /alcohol regulations requires employers to remove the employee from all safety sensitive duties and contact a SAP for evaluation
- Positive urine test for drugs
- Refusal to take a drug /alcohol test
- Failure to submit to drug test in a timely manner

Return to Duty

To meet DOT return to work requirements at the current position or any future DOT regulated positions the employee must be evaluated by a SAP and complete a remedial treatment or intervention program before they can be released back to safety sensitive work.




Substance Abuse Professional Department of Transportation

The US Dept. of Transportation requires specialized training for Substance Abuse Professionals (SAP's) conducting DOT compliant substance evaluations for employees in safety sensitive duties.

In addition to substance abuse certification, DOT/SAP's must complete 12-hours of specialized training every three years and pass a national exam specific to DOT guidelines.

To be in compliance with DOT guidelines only a SAP and not just any drug and alcohol counselor can evaluate you.
